Transitions, territorial governance and solidarity

Call for papers

In recent decades, the state's role as the guarantor of territorial justice has been profoundly challenged. The redistribution of resources by central states is becoming increasingly fragile as economic shifts (tertiarization, liberalization) and political changes (globalization, Europeanization and decentralization) alter the parameters of governance. The processes making wealth more or less concentrated, coupled with the changes generated by the ecological transition, are upsetting the hierarchical order between territories, and producing new forms of inequality, or "downgrading".

In the face of these major changes, regional science can be employed to understand how collective action reorganizes itself and becomes hybrid, involving multiple levels that combine issues like governance, sustainable development, and citizen participation. Top-down, standardized models of public action find themselves competing with alternative models featuring more horizontal, territorialized regulation methods.

The 58th ASRDLF symposium will look closely at these shifts taking place. The following questions will for example be tackled: What economic, social, political and ecological changes are under way at territorial scales? Can new territorial inequalities be identified? How does the ecological transition alter spatial balances and local policy capacities? The focus will be on the role played by local systems in governing transitions and inclusive action, encouraging a fresh multidisciplinary approach.

In parallel with the main theme, "Transitions, territorial governance and solidarity", broken down into 7 targeted sessions, proposals for papers can also correspond to one of the recurring sessions or special sessions, which very broadly cover regional science research questions. Paper proposals must include the following:

1. Contact details of the author(s) (surname, first name, title, affiliation, email).
2. The title of the proposed paper.
3. The name of one or two sessions (targeted, recurring, or special) to which the proposal corresponds.
4. An 800-word summary setting out the objective of the paper, the originality of the subject, the method and the results.
5. A list of five keywords.
6. A bibliography specific to the proposal (maximum 10 titles).

A prize will be awarded to the best paper written and presented by one (or several) doctoral student(s) or young doctor(s) (submission requirements can be found at : <https://asrdlf2022.org/appel-communications>)


